MEND is a **free** healthy lifestyle program for children and their families. MEND is offered through a partnership with Alberta Health Services and community partners.

MEND 7-13 is for children aged 7 to 13 years who are above a healthy weight and their families. The program has 20 sessions that spread over 10 weeks. Each session is 2 hours long and includes family activities, information, and physical activity.

MEND 7-13 will start again in Airdrie this fall on Tuesday September 20th, and runs every Tuesday and Thursday, 6:30-8:30 PM, until Thursday November 24th. Participants can call Health Link at 8-11 to register or online at www.ahs.ca/mend
