- ◆ Council approved first reading of an application to change residential zoning on First Street West to accommodate multi unit housing.

Property Taxation Notices

Due to the delay in getting tax notices out to residents, the deadline for payment has been extended to **Wednesday, August 3rd**. Tax notices were sent out to all residents in June. If you are interested in participating in the TIPP (Tax Installment Payment Plan) Program, or if you have any other questions, please contact the Village office. The TIPP program allows you to pay your property tax on a monthly basis instead of doing it in a single payment.



International Program Visits Cremona
