

Fire Ban Lifted

Thanks to the recent substantial moisture, local resources returning from Provincial deployments and a reduction in the fire risk to the County, the Fire Ban has been lifted effective immediately.

With that being said, the public is still urged to exercise extreme caution while burning and use precautionary measures such as screens and spark arrestors on burning barrels, cultivate areas surrounding controlled burns and have a supply of water readily available at all times.

Please note, that area located within the Forest Protection Area remains in a Fire Ban state and is regulated by the Province of Alberta. Details on their bans and restrictions can be found at: https://www.albertafirebans.ca/
