

## Council Update

Council held it's regular meeting March 15th, 2022. Council heard a final report on the Mountain View Regional Tourism Master plan. This plan was a collaborative effort involving Mountain View County, the towns of Carstairs, Didsbury, Olds and Sundre, as well as the Village of Cremona.

Council also approved a Subdivision on Railway Avenue. This was a straightforward subdivision that allowed the owner to separate three properties that were originally held on only one title instead of three.

The Village of Cremona, Eco Growth Environmental and the Cremona Bottle Depot officially launched the Food dehydration pilot project March 26th, with MP Earl Dreeshen in attendance. Residents can now bring all organic waste to the Bottle Depot and put through a dehydration system. Through this process, Eco Growth Environmental is turning this dehydrated food waste into a Biomass that can be used for Energy.
