

## ***Fees***

### **Resident Cremona & Mountain View County:**

\$350 + \$350 Perpetual care

### **Non-Resident**

\$1000 + \$1000 Perpetual care

### **Opening & Closing**

#### **Summer:**

\$350 or \$50 for Cremains

#### **Winter:**

\$450 or \$75 for Cremains

### **Overtime Hours:**

*(weekend, holidays after 3:00 p.m.)*

\$50 per hour per person

### **Memorial Wall Fees**

*(plus engraving costs)*

\$100 + \$200 Perpetual care

Memorial plaques are placed permanently. Any additional engraving will have to be done on site at your cost.

GST to be added to all fees.

## ***Rules & Regulations***

**Below are a few general that are set out in Cemetery Bylaw 385-05 which you should be aware of:**

All flowers, funeral designs or floral pieces will be removed from lots thirty (30) days after interment. The Village will then add sod during the cemetery maintenance period. The Village shall have the authority to remove any flowers, funeral designs or floral pieces, which are in the opinion of the Village unsightly or interferes with regular maintenance.

No monuments will be permitted that are manufactured of wood, metal, plastics, glass, tin, iron or combinations thereof unless it is for a purpose which as for holding flowers or other tributes as approved by the Chief Administrative Officer..

All monuments within the cemetery located at Lot 2, Block 1, Plan 0412649 NW-35-29-04-W5M (new cemetery) shall be placed on the ribbon.

No lot shall be covered by any slab of concrete, stone or other similar material. The lot will be sown to grass by the Village and kept level with the surroundings.

The Village may remove all installations at the cemetery made without authorization by the Village.



## ***What you need to know about the Cremona Cemeteries***

The Village of Cremona operates two cemeteries. They are set in one of the most beautiful parts of Alberta and provides a peaceful and tranquil resting place.

The oldest cemetery was established in 1936 and is located approximately 1 km east of Cremona on Hwy. 580. It is set on a picturesque hill and overlooks the newer cemetery which was established in 2000 and is directly east.

The oldest cemetery is nearly at its capacity and the only plots remaining are infill plots that are between rows. Should you request one of these plots, careful planning is required.

The newer cemetery has many plots available to choose from. Please inquire at the Village Office which plots are available for purchase.

## ***Procedure for purchasing a plot***

Plots can be purchased directly at the Village Office. Village staff will be pleased to help you select an available plot that best meets you and your family's needs. You may visit the cemetery at any time to see what may suit your needs.

Fees are listed on the other side of this brochure. Fees may change from time to time so please ask Village staff the most up to date fees.

The Village of Cremona requires that a Burial Permit be applied for. All grave sites require a liner. Interim details can be worked out between the funeral director and Village staff.

The purchase of plots can only be done by the individual at the Village Office not by the funeral home/director.

## ***Pre-purchased Plots***

Village staff are happy to assist you with selecting a plot that you wish to purchase now. Once purchased, this plot is recorded and reserved in the intendeds name. If you pre-purchased a plot, current information must be on file at the Village Office. Please ensure that if your contact information changes you contact the Village Office as soon as possible. This will ensure that your reservation is valid, in circumstances where information is not up-to-date, your plot may be sold and your pre-purchased payment will be forfeit.

## ***Cremation Plots***

Urn or cremation plots can be purchased from the Village for the same price as a regular plot. There is a maximum capacity of 8 cremains per plot depending on the characteristics of plot. It is important to know that all cremains in each plot must be recorded and on file at the Village Office.

## ***Memorial Wall***

The Memorial Wall is a place where you can hang plaques of loved ones who have been buried elsewhere, or had their ashes scattered. This provides a place for families to visit and remember their loved ones. A plaque can be purchased from the Village Office and sent for engraving. Plaques are to be returned to the Village Office and they will be installed by Village Staff in order of being received.

Engraving is currently being done by Legacy Monuments at 403.340.3426.
