

Regular Council Meeting Highlights July 18, 2023

- ◆ Council approved a request that the CAO engage with Alberta Transportation to seek out larger speed signage for Hwy 22 & Hwy 580.
- ◆ As the Village of Cremona's Cemetery By-law No. 385-05 does not indicate headstone sizes, Council approved that the maximum size for a headstone on an urn plot be 2ft wide by 1.31ft deep.
- ◆ Council approved a road closure for Saturday, September 9, 2023 from 7:00am to 4:30pm for the Cremona/Water Valley & District Chamber of Commerce to host the Annual Show & Shine event. Roads affected are Centre St., from Railway Ave. to 1st Ave. and 1st St. W. to 1st St. E.
