This Organizational meeting also involved the appointment of councillors to the various boards and committees that the Village supports.

The organizational meeting was followed by two orientation meetings. The first was a Regional elected officials orientation held October 29th. This one day session involved newly elected officials from throughout Mountain View County. A second orientation specifically for Cremona Council, was held Saturday, November 6th.

Council held its first regular meeting on November 16th, and its second regular meeting is set for December 21st. In the new year your council will focus on the direction of the Village over the next four years, through work on a new strategic plan, followed by supporting operating and capital budgets.
