DESIGNATED OFFICER FOR THE POSITION ASSESSOR BYLAW NO. 475-17

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CEMONA IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF DESIGNATED OFFICER TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ASSESSOR FOR THE VILLAGE OF CREMONA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties, and functions of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, THE Council of the Village of Cremona in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the position of Assessor be established to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor as designated in the Municipal Government Act.
2. That this bylaw is effective upon the date of its third and final reading.

Read a second time on this 19 day of September, 2017.

Unanimous consent granted for third and final reading on this 19 day of September, 2017

Read a third time and passed on this 19 day of September, 2017.
