Surviving the Holidays

Navigating grief and loss can be hard at any time of the year, the holidays can be a major trigger for memories of loved ones who have died, family traditions that can no longer happen due to strained relationships or separation, or the empty seat at the table. If you are living with grief, loss, trauma, or loneliness, it can be easy to compare your situation to others', which can increase feelings of loneliness or sadness. Take time to check in with yourself and your feelings and have realistic expectations for how the holiday season will be.

If holiday observances seem inauthentic right now, you do not need to force yourself to celebrate. During this time, connect with and plan to check in with a support group, a therapist, a faith community, or friends who understand. As much as possible, let your loved ones know how they can support you, whether it's helping you with shopping or meeting up for a regular walk. Often, people want to help but don't know what to say or where to start.

If you are dealing with loss or grief, gently remind yourself that as circumstances change, traditions will change as well.




