The Good Food Box Program, (GFB) is a program under the Community Kitchen Program of Calgary, whereby anyone can purchase boxes of fresh fruits and vegetables at an affordable price.

The boxes are assembled and distributed by volunteers to get fruits and vegetable to people in the Calgary and surrounding areas access to healthy food.

*Note that as of January 2026 there will be a price increase as follows

Small box \$40 ~20-25lbs

Medium box \$45 ~25-30lbs

Large box \$50 ~ 35-40lbs






