Organizational Council Meeting Highlights October 29, 2025

- The new Council was sworn in on October, 29, 2025.
- Council appointed Councillor Christina Liu as Deputy Mayor.
- Council approved that Official Administrator, Doug Lagore, be removed as a signing authority for the Village of Cremona with Servus Credit Union.
- Council Appointed Mayor Craig Lamb and Deputy Mayor Christina Liu as signing authorities for the Village of Cremona with Servus Credit Union.
- Council appointed Council members to various Boards, Committees & Commissions.
- Council declared the third Tuesday of each month as its Regular Council Meetings commencing at 7:00 pm in the Village of Cremona Council Chambers, 106 1st Avenue East, with a casual coffee time for the public starting at 6:30 pm.
- Council approved the Remuneration & Expense Policy No. 1601-01 with no changes.
- Council acknowledged that a copy of Bylaw No. 474-17 Code of Conduct was provided to the Members. One signed copy will be retained at the Village office and one by each member of Council.
- Council accepted the outdoor rink presentation as information only.
