

Regular Council Meeting Minutes May 19, 2026

- ◆ Council directed Administration to prepare cost estimates, funding options, timelines, and recommendations for Council consideration with regards to the following priority order for 2026 Capital Projects: 1.) Third Street East underground infrastructure and top paving. 2.) Playground replacement on Edey Close; and 3.) Chip sealing of East Street.
- ◆ Council accepted the 2026 Operational Budget as amended.
- ◆ Council scheduled a Committee in Whole meeting to review the Procedural Bylaw 214-25 for May 26, 2026, at 7 pm.
- ◆ Council set November 2, 2026 as the date for the 2026 Public Auction for the addressed properties at the Council Chambers starting at 10 am.
- ◆ Council approved the presented Terms and Conditions of Sale for the Public Auction.
- ◆ Council approved sponsorship of the 1st Annual Buckin' in the Village in the amount of \$300.00.
- ◆ Council approved the road closure request from the AG Society during their Buckin' in the Village event. The closure will be of 1st Street, north from 1st Avenue for the period of June 12 & 13, 2026.
