

# ASIST Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training

Suicide first-aid. A two-day, skills- based workshop for intervening with a person at risk of suicide.

#### Learning objectives:

- Recognize that caregivers and persons at risk are affected by personal and societal attitudes about suicide
- Discuss suicide with a person at risk in a direct manner
- Identify risk alerts and develop a safe plan related to them
- Demonstrate the skills required to intervene with a person at risk of suicide

Ages 18+. Participants can include but not limited to: parents and caregivers; natural helpers and advisors; educators and ministers; health practitioners; justice, law enforcers, emergency workers, and community volunteers. Not recommended for people who have had a recent suicide loss.

#### Cremona Events/Services

Hope 4 MVC Kids Society is a non-profit, registered charity founded in November 2013. Entirely volunteer-run, the society supports families across Mountain View County who have children facing medical challenges. We provide assistance through the programs, outlined below:

**Program 1:** offers assistance to local children who are hospitalized. This includes support for parking, meals, fuel, and sibling care. For longterm hospital stays, additional help may be available, including rent, mortgage, and utility assistance.

Program 2: provides support for local children needing adaptive equipment for home or school, which is not covered by other funding sources.

**Program 3**: assists children who require home modifications due to illness or disability, also not covered by other resources.

**Program 4:** helps local children needing therapeutic services, such as counseling, occupational therapy, physical therapy, mental health support, or alternative therapies that are not covered by health insurance.

**Program 5:** extends assistance for prescription medications that aren't covered by health insurance.

**Program 6:** offers support, advocacy, information to families navigating a child's illness condition are gratefully accepted. or diagnosis. With the personal experiences of our board members, we

understand the challenges faced andcan guide families to additional resources and support.




