

Special Council Meeting Highlights October 7, 2024

- ◆ Official Administrator Doug Lagore moves that the by-election established by resolution #24/196 on September 17th be hereby cancelled as the legislative requirements for advertising, as detailed in the Local Authorities Election Act, were not met
- ◆ Official Administrator Doug Lagore moves that pursuant to Sec. 13(1) (b) of the Local Authorities Election Act, the date for the by-election be established as Monday, November 25, 2024.

Regular Council Meeting Highlights September 17, 2024

- ◆ Official Administrator Doug Lagore acknowledged the MVRWMC 2025 Operating Budget with Cremona 2025 requisition being \$ 13,623.
- ◆ Official Administrator Doug Lagore approved Parkland Regional Library's 2025 Proposed Budget with a slight increase of 0.63 cents, equaling \$9.81 per capita, with the Village of Cremona requisition being \$4,286.97.
- ◆ Official Administrator Doug Lagore be authorized to retain the legal firm of Reynolds, Mirth, Richards, and Farmer LLP to recover funds spent without proper legal authority and any other legal matters deemed necessary.
