ASIST Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training

Suicide first-aid. A two-day, skills-based workshop for intervening with a person at risk of suicide.

Learning objectives:

- Recognize that caregivers and persons at risk are affected by personal and societal attitudes about suicide
- Discuss suicide with a person at risk in a direct manner
- Identify risk alerts and develop a safe plan related to them
- Demonstrate the skills required to intervene with a person at risk of suicide

Ages 18+. Participants can include but not limited to: parents and caregivers; natural helpers and advisors; educators and ministers; health practitioners; justice, law enforcers, emergency workers, and community volunteers. Not recommended for people who have had a recent suicide loss.

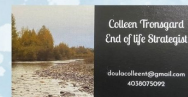

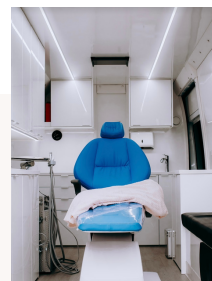

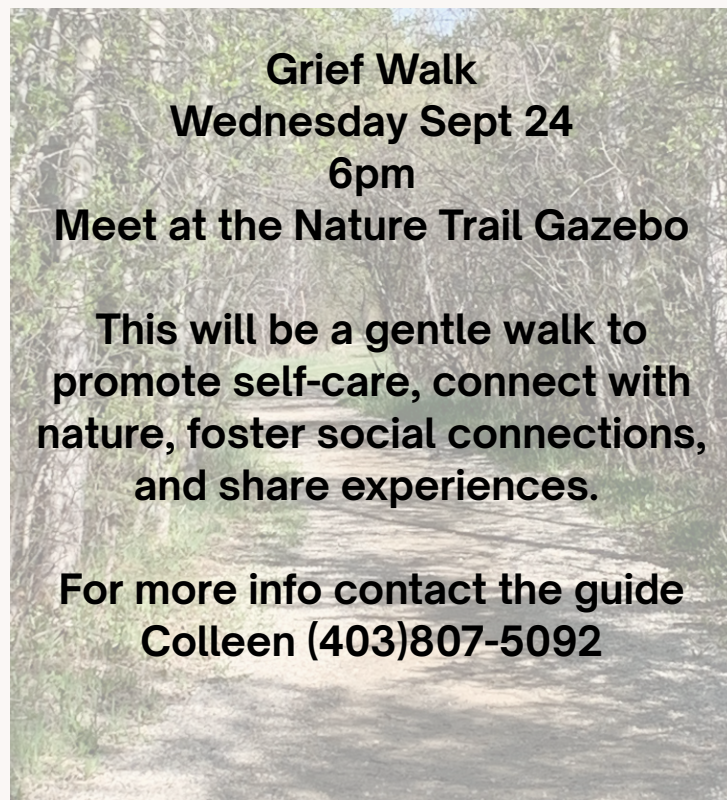

You will learn how to make a finger woven bookmark or bracelet in this beginner 3 hr class. Shauna will also bring her loom and demonstrate it.

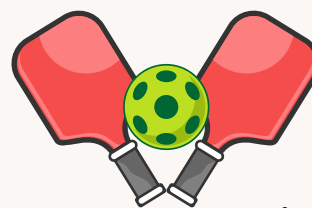
