Intervention Skills
Training

Suicide first-aid. A two-day, skills- based workshop for intervening with a person at risk of suicide.

Learning objectives:

- Recognize that caregivers and persons at risk are affected by personal and societal attitudes about suicide
- Discuss suicide with a person at risk in a direct manner
- Identify risk alerts and develop a safe plan related to them
- Demonstrate the skills required to intervene with a person at risk of suicide

Ages 18+. Participants can include but not limited to: parents and caregivers; natural helpers and advisors; educators and ministers; health practitioners; justice, law enforcers, emergency workers, and community volunteers. Not recommended for people who have had a recent suicide loss.





Join Shauna Taylor as she leads a beginner class on the traditional method of weaving Metis sashes, finger weaving. Shauna is a proud Red River Métis woman who has spent time learning from an elder, Mary from her dad's home community in MB, how to weave sashes on a homemade Inkle loom and the teachings of the sash. Shauna, along with her Father, Marvin Goodon, attend schools and communities teaching Metis culture, hunting and trapping and teachings of the Metis sash. You will learn how to make a finger woven bookmark or bracelet in this beginner 3 hr class. Shauna will also bring her loom and demonstrate it.




