

Volunteer Tax Program 2023

Taxpayer status	Family Income
Single Person	Up to \$35,000
Two People (e.g. Couple without Children, Single adult with one child)	Up to \$45,000
Three People	Up to \$47,500
Four People	Up to \$50,000
Five People	Up to \$52,500
More than five people	\$55,000 plus \$2,500 for each additional person

Some guidelines do apply: volunteers CANNOT prepare income tax returns with:

- Capital gains
- Farming income
- Self-employed income
- Fishing income
- Deceased persons

- Interest income over \$1,000
- Rental income
- Bankruptcies
- Returns over five years old

Anyone wishing to participate in this program must fill out a form (TIS60) which will allow a Community Volunteer to prepare your income tax and benefit return.

The form is available at the Cremona FCSS and will only take a minute to fill out when you drop off your tax and benefit information at the Cremona FCSS 106 1st Avenue East.

Residents must provide all employment T-4s and government tax slips






FCSS HOURS




Carrie Watts may be old, but she suffers no shortage of spirit. She
