

SUMMER READING PROGRAM ASSISTANT

JOB DESCRIPTION

This is an eight-week term position, one day per week, 4 hour afternoon shifts, plus a paid orientation shift prior to program start. You will be responsible for organizing and delivering the Summer Reading Club at the library, under the supervision and guidance of the Library Manager.

Working with other Summer Reading Program Assistants, you will supervise and guide a group of 5 to 12 year olds through a summer of fun, reading and activities both indoors and outdoors.
