UNPAID UTILITY

ACCOUNT NOTICE

Should any of the Village of Cremona Utility monthly

billing remain unpaid for more than sixty (60) days following the date of the billing, the Village of Cremona shall have the right to enforce payment by transfer of the unpaid amount to the property tax account or the right to disconnect the water supply to the property.

There are several payment options available to you:

- Payment by phone or on-line—contact your bank for details;
- 2. In person at the Village Office—we accept cash, cheque and debit;
- Mail—a cheque can be mailed to: Village of Cremona, Box 10, Cremona AB TOM ORO;
- 4. Mail drop box—your payment can be put in the drop box located on the front of the Village Office main doors.

If payment is not received the Village may apply your outstanding balance to your property tax account.
