A few questions we are receiving:

- Can we have access to the mapping of the evacuation zones or what you see on the Alberta Emergency Alerts?
  - We currently do not have a publicly available layer for areas under evacuations order. These are determined by the local authority (municipality).
  - The polygons that you see are just demonstrative, and is why alerts may be issued with road coordinates at the time or later for clarity.

- Can we be advised before evacuations are lifted?
  - Local authorities make those decisions. The Provincial Emergency Coordination Centre nor the Alberta government make those decisions.
  - The Provincial State of Emergency does provide the Alberta government with an ability to find more resources and access other funding but it does not give us authority over local authorities and their individual states of emergency or evacuation orders.

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
